The driver SHALL conduct a pre-use inspection and submit a written report which shall be kept on file for no less than three years. The report shall list any defect or deficiency discovered that could affect sa fe operation of the vehicle. If no defect or deficiency is discovered the report shall so indicate. Each operator shall submit a signed and dated **Daily Inspection Report** for each PIT vehicle they drive. (Cal/OSHA reg 8 CCR 3650 and CUSD Board Policy 8501)
