<p>Call to Order Hilda Martinez called the meeting to order at 3:01p.m.. She introduced herself to the committee members and thanked everyone for attending today’s DELAC meeting.</p>	<p>Call to Order, Introductions</p>
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LCP

Robb Christopherson stated that the Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan is a key part of the overall budget package for K-12 that seeks to address funding stability for schools while providing information at the local educational agency level for how student learning continuity will be address during COVID-19 crisis in the 2020-21 school year. As of today, we had provided 19,047 loaner laptops and 10,991 hot spots to CUSD students.

He shared the response the District wrote and ask for comments and suggestions:

1. Continuity of Learning (In-Person Instruction Offerings) – option for fully online or tradition model of instruction. Student and staff health are our top priority. Campus safety. Preschool and ASES program
2. Continuity of Learning (Distance Learning Program) - CUSD is committed to providing ongoing support, guidance, and resources for both teachers and students. Intervention support to all students with unique needs, including English Learners
3. Continuity of Learning (Pupil Learning Loss) – The essential standards are the key learnings and support most of the instructional time. It will be a major focus in the 2020-21 school year. English Language Development (ELD) elementary students received 30 minutes of instruction targeted to their language proficiency. Student in Secondary school have a period designated as ELD each day.
4. Mental Health and Social Emotional Well-Being – Tiers of support. Clovis Unified Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) team has continued support teachers in maintaining social-emotional connections with students while being socially distant
5. Pupil and Family Engagement and Outreach – The district has worked extensively to perform outreach to students and parents
6. School Nutrition – CUSD’s schools provide nutritious meals to students five days a week
7. Increased or Improved Services for Foster Youth, English Learners, and Low-Income – the needs of these students are prioritized and areas where additional support is needed, actions and services are put in place to meet these needs

CUSD Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan will be posted on the website from Sept 2, 2020 to September 9, 2020. There is a public hearing to be held on September 9, 2020 at 6:45 p.m. at the Governing Board meeting. After reviewed and approved by the Governing Board at the September 23, 2020 meeting then it will be presented to the county.
