Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)

Robb Christopherson stated that the LCAP is a key part of the overall budget package for K-12 that seeks to address funding stability for schools.

- **Discussed top three District aims/goals.**
 - Maximize achievement for ALL students.
 - Operate with increasing efficiency and effectiveness.
 - Hire, Develop, sustain, and value a quality diverse workforce

- **Proposed LCAP Action / Service:**
 - Support student wellness with a District-Wide Health Clinic
 - Increase access to technology
 - English Learner Teacher and Support
 - Expanded Action / Services

He asked the committee members for feedback and recommendations on the top three aims. The google form feedback will be sent out tomorrow, your input is valued and taken to the Superintendent. The committees will receive a written response from Dr. Eimear O’Farrell, CUSD Superintendent and moved for CUSD Governing Board Approval in June, followed by the Fresno County Superintendent of School (FCSS) reviewing our document for final approval

- **LCAP Timeline**
 - May 2021- Governing Board schedules a Public Hearing and receives LCAP Draft
 - May 2021 - LCAP Public Hearing is held; LCAP Public comment period ends
 - May - June 2021 - Writing team finalizes CUSD LCAP
 - June 2021 - Governing Board receives recommendations for CUSD LCAP
 - July 2021 - LCAP due to Fresno County Superintendent of Schools
 - Fall 2021 - Annual Update and LCAP Review

Perkins Grant

Dr. Gregory Lomack stated that each year we apply for the Perkins Grant. The funds received serve to provide instructional material, capital outlay equipment, industry tours, professional and curriculum for students and teachers participating in Career Technical Education (CTE) pathways. Your responses to the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA) Survey allow us to set funding priorities which are very important to the Grant Application Process.
