Mission Statement

An English Language Advisory Committee (ELAC) must be formed whenever a school has over 21 or more English Learners (ELs) students. The ELAC must meet at least quarterly to discuss issues relative to the success of ELs. Each school is to nominate a District English Language Advisory Committee Member (DELAC) that would attend district level meetings and bring back and share district level information to their own school community as well as bring issues, concerns or needs to the DELAC. The purpose of an ELAC is to provide parents of English Learners the opportunity to:

1. Participate in the school's needs assessments of students, parents and teachers.
2. Advise the principal and school staff on the school's program for English Learners.
3. Provide input on the most effective ways to ensure regular school attendance.
4. Assist the school on the annual language census and providing input for the reclassification process.
5. Advise the School Site Council on the development of the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA).

Anytime there are 51 or more EL students in the district, there shall be a functioning District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC). It is important that each school site ELAC elect a DELAC representative and arrange to have that representative attend every DELAC meeting. The committee receives training materials and training to assist parent members in carrying out their responsibility. Currently the DELAC bylaws require each DELAC representative to be:

- a parent/guardian of an EL or former EL (i.e., a reclassified fluent English proficient student) currently enrolled at the site he/she represents, and
- elected to serve as the DELAC representative by the site ELAC.

The purpose of DELAC is to provide parents of English Learners the opportunity to review and revise the CUSD Master Plan: A Guide to Providing Services for English Learners. In addition, the DELAC conducts an annual district wide Needs Assessment and provides information to the site's ELAC. Annually the District's Reclassification process and data are presented to the committee for review and comment on the district reclassification procedures. Reclassification data is also presented and reviewed by site and district.
