EARLY COMPLETION OPTION CRITERIA

Senate Bill 57 (Scott) was designed to allow eligible individuals to complete an induction program at a faster pace than the two years generally required to complete all requirements. Early Completion Option (ECO) Participating Teachers have the opportunity to complete the induction program in one year. This option is available to **experienced**, **exceptional** candidates who meet the eligibility criteria listed below and demonstrate the knowledge, skills, abilities, and competencies required of all teacher candidates who complete the full-length program. All candidates are informed of the ECO at the time of enrollment in the program. Eligible teachers must apply for this **option by 4:00 p.m. on September 13, 2023.**

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for ECO, candidates must:


- Hold a Preliminary Multiple, Single Subject, or Education Specialist Teaching credential and be employed in a California school and have passed the RICA and their TPA's as applicable.
- Provide evidence of two years of prior successful teaching experience as the teacher of record in a Preschool Grade 12 teaching assignment.
- Verification of teaching experience including rigorous positive evaluations from current and past site administrators.
- Have written recommendation from a current Site or District Administrator attesting to candidate's appropriateness for early completion.

(Candidates clearing dual credentials are not eligible for ECO.)

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Participating Teachers must submit a completed application packet to <u>Phil Smith</u>, Lead Instructional Coach, Induction by 4:00 p.m. on September 13, 2023 which includes:
 - Cover Letter
 - A well-written one-page rationale explaining how you meet the criteria for ECO.
 The rationale should reflect on your exemplary practice, attitudes, professionalism, and commitment to teaching aligned with the California Standards for the Teaching Profession.
 - Early Completion Option Application completed by candidate
 - Two formal evaluations from two separate years (2022.23 SY & 2021.22 SY)
 - o By current or prior site administrator for whom you have demonstrated successful teaching practices. Evaluations must be from a site administrator. Though evaluations can be completed by current site administrators, they must be from prior years. Evaluations completed for the current school year (2023.24) are not applicable.
- 2. Early Completion Option Administrator Recommendation, Pg. 3 (emailed/mailed directly to Phil Smith- this portion of the packet SHALL NOT be included with the other sections)
 - Completed by current site administrator
 - o Attest to the appropriateness of your placement in the Early Completion Option
- 3. Video submission of a standards-based lesson taught by the PT from the 2023.24 SY (attach the related lesson plan)

If an ECO Participating Teacher (PT) is not successfully progressing on pace for early completion of the program, or if the PT fails to demonstrate skills and abilities on a level expected of, and consistent with an early completion candidate, adjustments will be made as deemed necessary and appropriate by Induction Program Leadership. If necessary, the candidate will be placed in the regular full-length induction program.
