Dear DAC, DELAC, Foster & Homeless Youth, Migrant Education Representatives,

Thank you for your participation in the 2021 District Advisory Committee (DAC)/District English Language Advisory Committee (DELAC), Foster and Homeless Youth joint meeting held on May 4, 2021. The meeting provided an opportunity to review and discuss Clovis Unified School District's 2021-2022 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). Your assistance in providing feedback on the proposed actions and services included in the LCAP is invaluable, and we were pleased with the overall support voiced by attendees at this meeting.

Dr. Robb Christopherson presented our LCAP for a final review for our DELAC, DAC, Migrant Committees, Homeless and Foster Youth as well as our various other community representative. These committees play an important role in providing and reviewing the final document. The proposed actions and services affirmed by attendees at this meeting are designed around ten focus areas identified by parents, students and employees. These include:

- Fund Sierra Vista Student Health Center
- Increase access to technology
- Coordinator of EL services
- Addition of iReady reading and supplemental literature
- Increase of push-in teacher and intervention time for elementary
- Increase secondary site intervention stipends (4 intermediate and 6 high school)
- Addition of Area Coaches to support professional development in math, English language arts, and technology
- District Lead Counselor
- Addition of Director of LCAP
- Personnel for Student Services and School Attendance for Foster and Homeless support

In addition, attendees at this meeting asked for more dialogue about the use of technology and continuing to use what works well from "virtual learning" and incorporate it into daily classes while increases access for students. These recommendations have been incorporated into the proposed LCAP. Attendees also shared the need to increase access to the Student Health Center.

Please accept our deepest appreciation for the part you played in developing a proposed plan that best serves all Clovis Unified Students. We appreciate the candid dialogue shared
