Dear DAC, DELAC, Foster & Homeless Youth, Migrant Education Representatives,

Thank you for your participation in the 2020 District Advisory Committee (DAC), District English Language Advisory Committee (DELAC), Foster and Homeless Youth meetings held on September 1, 2020. The meetings provided an opportunity to review and discuss Clovis Unified School District's Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan (LCP). Your assistance in providing feedback on the proposed plan is invaluable, and we were pleased with the overall support voiced by attendees at these meeting.

Dr. Christopherson presented LCP for a final review by our DELAC, DAC, Migrant Committees, Homeless and Foster Youth as well as other community representative. These committees play an important role in reviewing the document and providing many valuable comments and opinions. The proposed plan supported by attendees at these meetings are designed around seven focus areas. These include:

1. **In-Person Instructional Offerings**
2. **Distance Learning Program**
3. **Pupil Learning Loss**
4. **Mental Health and Social and Emotional Well-Being**
5. **Pupil and Family Engagement and Outreach**
6. **School Nutrition**
7. **Increased or Improved Services for Foster Youth, English Learners, and Low-Income Students**

Meeting attendees commented that the distance learning that is currently in place seems to be working but students could use more one-on-one help and that students with greater needs are suffering the greatest loss of skills. Access to someone for one-on-one assistance would help support student social and emotional well-being as well as provide academic intervention. These recommendations have been incorporated into the proposed LCP.

Please accept our deepest appreciation for the part you played in developing a proposed plan that best serves all Clovis Unified Students. We appreciate the candid dialogue shared during our meetings, and we are committed to delivering the goals contained within the LCP. The current draft LCP is available to review online at www.cusd.com. The Governing Board is expected to take action on the proposal at its September 23, 2020, meeting.
