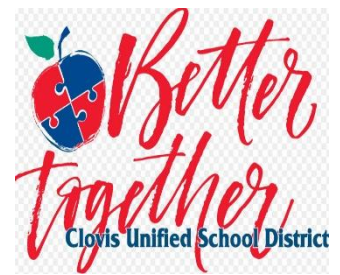

CUSD is committed to provide any and all funds and equitable services available. CUSD will offer not only equitable services, funding but also ongoing technical support as well as access to any professional development trainings and services offered in our district. The CUSD Technology Department offers services in the area of technology as well as throughout the year and summer. There are two instructional workshops (fall and winter) tailored to the needs of our sites and reflecting an Annual Needs Assessment conducted by our Private Schools. Other district and local professional development opportunities are available throughout the school year and open for attendance. There is access available to utilize CUSD Teacher Center for curriculum development and lesson preparation, graphics arts as well as the curriculum and professional development library.

Funding allocations are based on the school's enrollment of students residing within the CUSD Boundaries. All professional development, site and classroom visits are available for visitations. Decisions are made from our ongoing consultations beginning each spring. Consultations continue throughout the year and on as a needed basis. Budgets are discussed and managed the entire year. Projected allocations are provided and discussion centers on school needs. Each consultation focuses on school needs and what the district can offer in terms of services, programs, materials funding streams and staff development.
